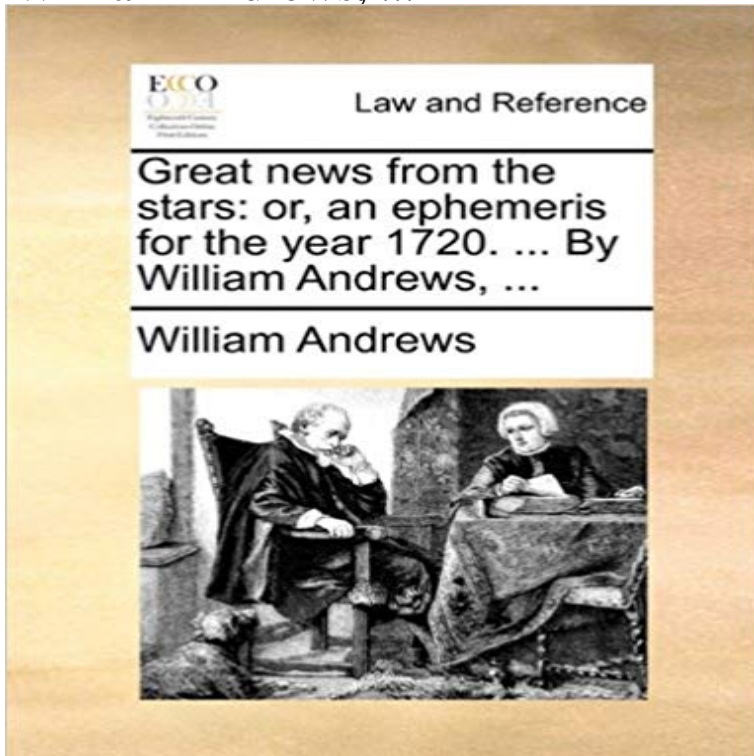


# Great news from the stars: or, an ephemeris for the year 1720. ... By William Andrews, ...
