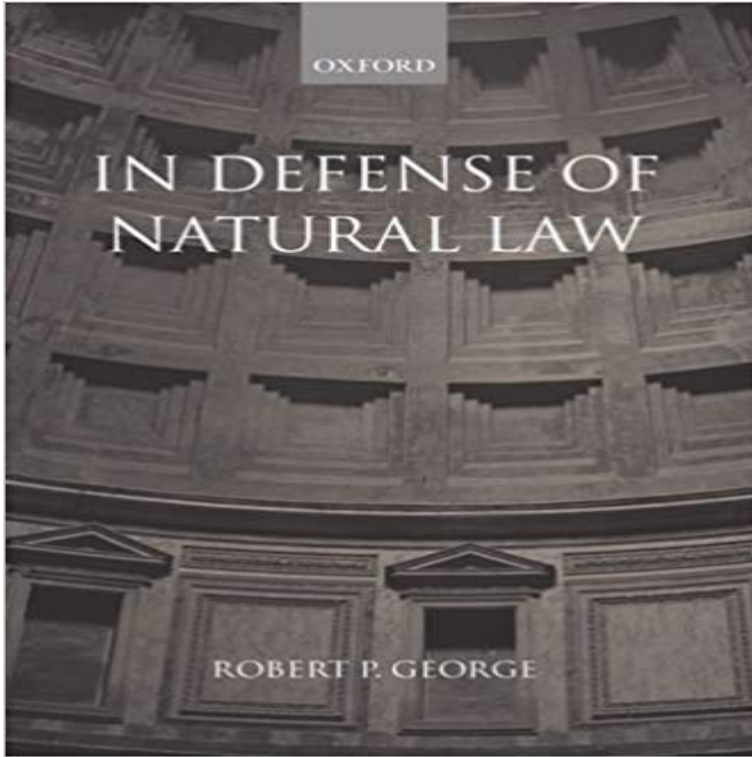


In Defense of Natural Law
