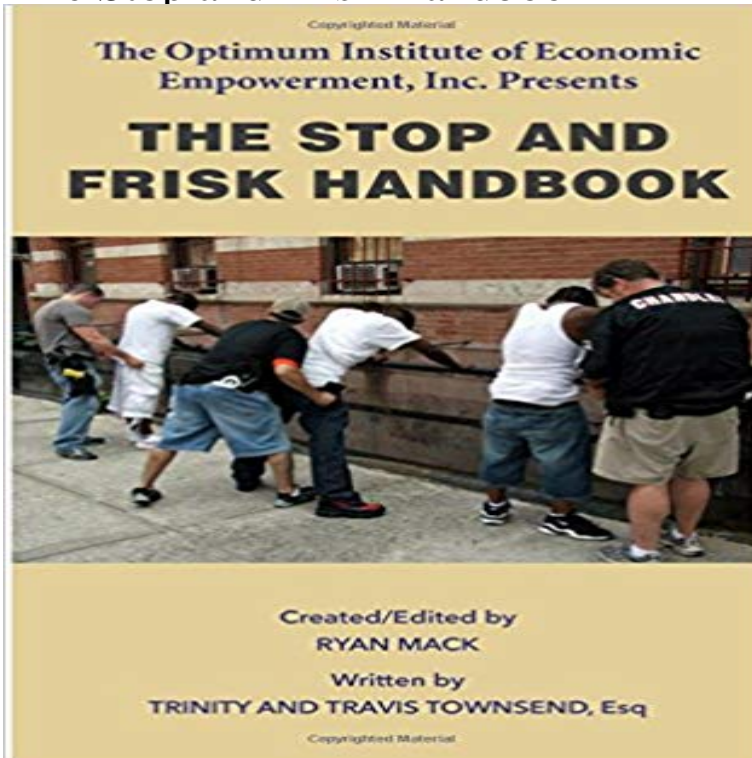


The Stop and Frisk Handbook
