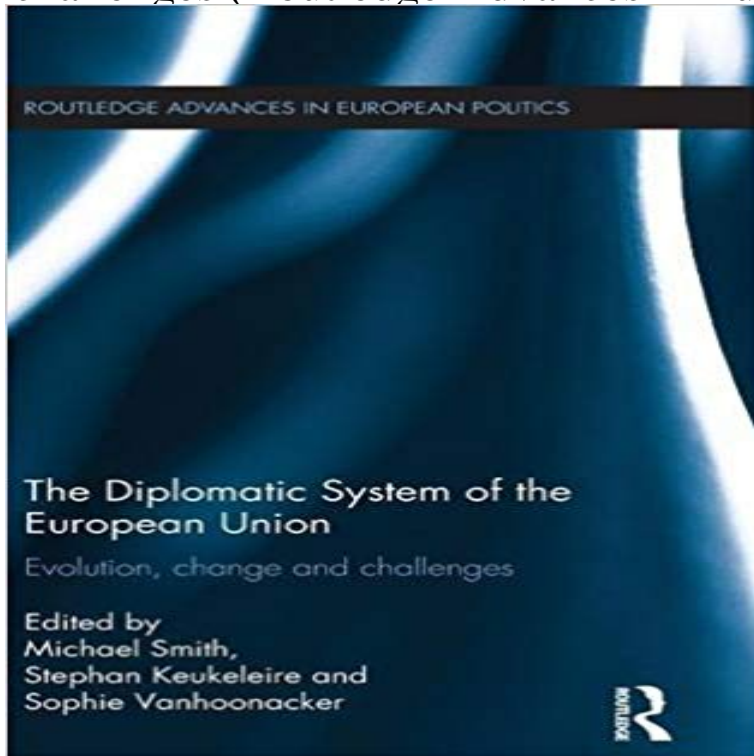


The Diplomatic System of the European Union: Evolution, change and challenges (Routledge Advances in European Politics)
