The issue also features extensive student research, in the form of Notes and Comments, on these cutting-edge subjects: mandatory arbitration and contract procedure as process-based incentives to stay in court; the concept of ride-through in bankruptcy law as an economic good which should be statutorily authorized; reform of kidney allocation and the limits of age discrimination law; and how civil law jurisdictions treat amici curiae parties and briefs, increasingly allowing them despite traditional practice. Quality ebook formatting includes fully linked notes and an active Table of Contents (including linked Contents for individual articles, notes, and essays), as well as active URLs in notes for cited web pages. The editors of The Yale Law Journal are a group of Yale Law School students, who also contribute Notes and Comments to the Journals content. The principal articles are written by leading legal scholars.
